Time to create a time capsule.

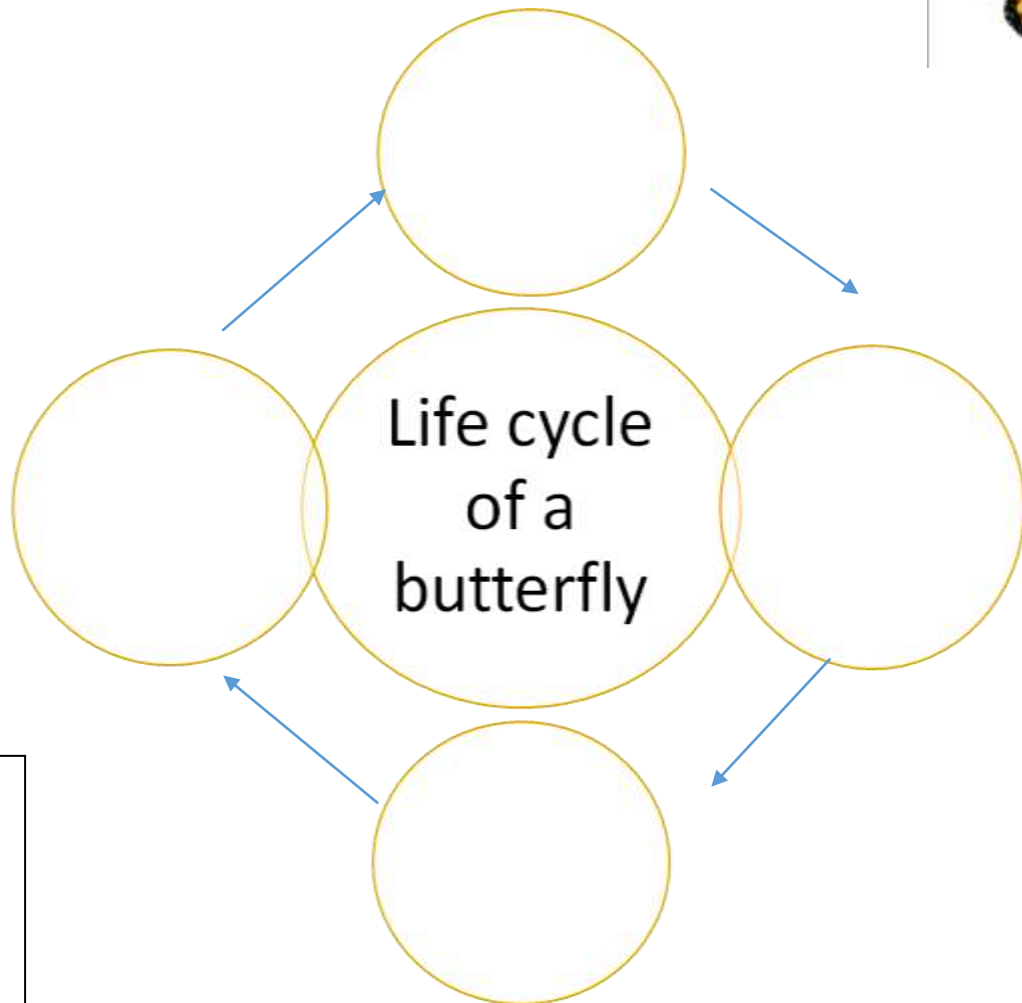
Here are your instructions:

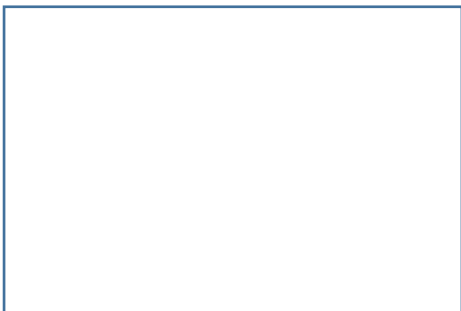
Life cycle of a butterfly



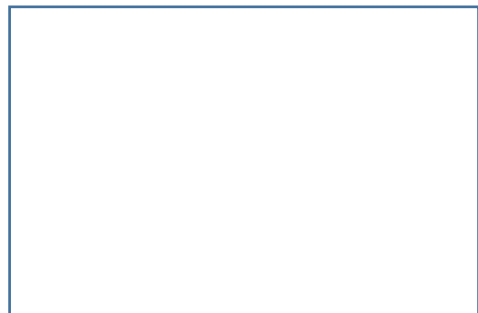
